Skin:

As we age, our skin grows thinner; it becomes drier and less elastic. Wrinkles appear, and cuts and bruises take longer to heal. Skin creams become essential. The skin also becomes more susceptible to the sun's rays. Be sure to protect your skin from the sun. Too much sun and ultraviolet rays can cause skin cancer.

Hearing:

As we age, our ears normally lose their ability to discern sounds in certain frequencies. A hearing loss often results in feelings of isolation or loneliness, which can trigger depression. A test can help to identify if a hearing loss is affecting your relationships with friends and family. Remember that the cost of hearing aids is included in most medical plans, and the aids themselves have become more effective and less obtrusive than those of the past.
