Computer Security Suggestions

If a suspicious pop-up suddenly appears (for example - telling you that your computer has problems), *immediately* do the following:

- Hold down the **CTRL** and **ALT** keys and at the same time press the **DELETE** key. When a blue/black screen appears, release the keys and you should be given some options.
 - Click on the Task *Manager* option.
 - In the next box, click on the *browser name* that you are using (Google, Firefox or Edge, for example).
 - Click *End Task* at the bottom left of the box.
 - Close the Task Manager Box.
- Restart the computer and carry on working!

The offending pop-up should be gone, and all your data and apps should be working.

Note: *NEVER* call the number they give you, or talk to anyone on the phone, or offer any comment. *No reputa-*

ble business or government agency will ever contact you in this way.
