#### February Breakfast in Review:

Presenters **Nicole Farn and Adrienne Wiebe** took us on a (virtual) 8-hour trek to a remote area in Nicaragua as they described the work of Change for Children. The organization was founded in 1976 by a small group of people in the Edmonton area who believed that concerned Albertans could make a positive impact in the fight against poverty and injustice in the world. In the decades since then, projects have been undertaken in Central America and the Caribbean, South America and Africa.

The projects focus on the priorities of:

- Clean Water
- Climate Change
- Food Sovereignty
- Health
- Education
- Indigenous Peoples

Projects are developed cooperatively with the communities involved with emphasis on identifying local needs and finding long-term solutions.

Through a slide presentation, we saw remote villages in the rainforests, schools built collaboratively and water and sanitation projects.

Would you like to be part of such an adventure? The Alberta Teachers Association has partnered with Change for Children and arranged 5 exchanges with Nicaragua and 3 with Guatemala. One will take place this coming summer. These tours take groups of 6 to 10 teachers to remote communities. 20 schools have been built – that is 20 schools equipped with technology, where local teachers have been provided with professional development and support.

In 2023, Canadian teachers participated in a teacher's brigade to Guatemala and to Nicaragua, in partnership with the Alberta Teacher's Association. Teachers experienced firsthand the time, effort, and challenges associated with education in resource-scarce communities. See their story:

  - On Morinville's trail system, accessible outside of the Morinville Leisure Centre, weather permitting, a distance of up to 8 kilometres.
- ARTA members are invited to contribute a non-perishable food item(s) to be donated to the local Food Bank.
- Complementary coffee and muffins will be provided to all participants.

### ARTA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

In keeping with its continuing support for education, the ARTA Scholarship Program is made possible by the generosity of ARTA Members and Orbit Insurance Services, a service partner for home and auto insurance. Orbit Insurance Services provides through ARTA, scholarships to students who are related to an ARTA member. These scholarships recognize academic achievement, community involvement and volunteer work. Future goals, personal accomplishment, and supporting letters of reference will also be significant in the overall determination of the scholarship recipients. Up to eight scholarships of \$5000 will be awarded in 2024.

ARTA also awards two scholarships for ARTA 101 Members (active teachers) and their relatives. ARTA awards one \$2500 scholarship annually to an active teacher pursuing additional education to support them in their career. ARTA also awards one \$2500 scholarship annually to the direct relative of an active teacher who is getting their first undergraduate degree or diploma and are in their second, third or fourth year of study.
