



Alberta Registry Discount for Seniors

As of July 1, the Alberta government has issued a new 25 per cent discount on driver's medical exams for seniors. Performed by a physician or nurse practitioner, this exam ensures that a person is medically fit to drive according to provincial guidelines. They are mandatory at age 75, 80, and every two years after that, starting at 82. However, some seniors with a medical condition might require the exam at an earlier age. This discount follows the provincial government's promise to keep life more affordable for seniors in Alberta.

To receive your discount take your proof of purchase or receipt to any Alberta Registry agent.
